Topic 2: Methods and tools to assess climate change impacts and adaptation

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of the information provided by the secretariat on the UNFCCC/IPCC meeting of experts on climate change impact and adaptation methodologies.
- 2. The SBSTA requested the secretariat to organize a workshop with participation of experts from the IPCC and the user community after acceptance of the IPCC Third Assessment Report. The workshop should explore:
- (a) The experience of developing countries in applying current impact and adaptation methodologies and their emerging needs;
- (b) The current state of the art of methods identified in the IPCC Third Assessment Report, and how these apply to the specific circumstances of developing countries;
- (c) Options for improving the quality and dissemination of information on impact and adaptation methodologies.
- 3. The SBSTA invited Parties to actively participate in and provide support for the workshop;
- 4. The SBSTA invited the secretariat to provide information on the results of the above-mentioned workshop at its fourteenth session.
