I. OPENING OF THE SESSION

1. The sixteenth session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) was held at the Maritim Hotel, Bonn, from 10 to 14 June 2002.
2. The Chair of the SBI, Mr. Raúl Estrada-Oyuela (Argentina), opened the session on 10 June 2002 and welcomed all Parties and observers to the session. He noted that, to date, a total of 186 Parties had ratified or acceded to the Convention and that 74 Parties had ratified or acceded to the Kyoto Protocol. He welcomed the new SBI bureau, composed of Ms. Daniela Stoytcheva (Bulgaria), Vice-Chair, and Ms. Emily Ojoo-Massawa (Kenya), Rapporteur.
3. The Chair welcomed Ms. Joke Waller-Hunter, the new Executive Secretary, and invited her to address the SBI.
