**ISSUES RELATED TO CLEANER OR LESS GREENHOUSE GAS-EMITTING ENERGY**

**Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair**

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of proposed approaches to issues related to cleaner or less greenhouse gas-emitting energy contained in document FCCC/SBSTA/2002/MISC.3 and documents FCCC/SBSTA/2002/MISC.3/Add.1 and Add.2 submitted by Canada and by Venezuela on behalf of the Group of 77 and China, respectively.
2. The SBSTA also took note of the report on the UNFCCC workshop on cleaner or less greenhouse gas-emitting energy: exchange of information and views contained in document FCCC/SBSTA/2002/INF.8.
3. The SBSTA did not complete its consideration of issues under sub-item 10 (b). It agreed to continue the consideration of these issues at its seventeenth session under the agenda sub-item “Other matters: issues related to cleaner or less greenhouse gas-emitting energy”.
