SUBMISSION FROM QATAR

The state of Qatar would like to add an additional paragraph to the negotiating text on article 4.8/4.9 of the convention and article 3.14 of the Kyoto Protocol. This paragraph has a unanimous support during the previous negotiating sessions. The paragraph reads as follow:

[Encourages Annex II parties to support developing country Parties in the development, investment, production, distribution and transportation of indigenous, less greenhouse gas emitting, "environmentally sound" (footnote referring to Agenda 21: that "environmentally sound" also implies "environmentally safe"), energy sources, in particular natural gas, according to the national circumstances of these Parties;]
